CIRCULAR:-

The Principals of the affiliated Colleges in Engineering are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Faculty of Technology at its meeting held on 23rd February, 2015 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 26th February, 2015 vide item No. 4.67 and that in accordance therewith, it was resolved as follows :-

The students those who will pass First Year (F.E.), Second Year (S.E) and Third Year (T.E) as per Revised 2007 and previous old syllabus will be allowed to enter upon B.E (Sem. VII & Sem. VIII) in Academic Year 2015-16 only as per Revised 2007 syllabus scheme as a special case.


Also the students those who will pass First Year (F.E), Second Year (S.E) and failed in not more than 5 heads of passing in Sem. V & Sem. VI taken together will be allowed to enter upon B.E. (Sem. VII & Sem. VIII) in Academic Year 2015-16 only as per Revised 2007 syllabus scheme as a special case.

However the students will have option to choose either of the schemes.

The classes for B.E. students of Revised 2007 scheme and Revised 2012 scheme (i.e. CBGS) need to be conducted separately by each college. If there is demand from colleges to form clusters to conduct theory and practical it will be permitted and it will be decided in common meeting of principals depending upon the number of students in each branch.
