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


Prof Deepak Dubey delivered a presentation on necessary information about the academic design of the first-year B.E. Course and the University norms and examination pattern.

MENTORING

PROFICIENCY MODULES

Based on the diagnostic test, weak students were found and for them, proficiency sessions were organized. The college implemented various Modules for the enhancement of the proficiency of the students in various subjects like English, Mathematics, and computers.

During these sessions, various experts and experienced faculties conducted crash courses on particular subjects. English crash course was conducted by Dr. Trupti Patil and Dr. Prashant Pawar. The mathematics course was held by Prof. Jayesh Jain, Prof. Shiksha Singh and Prof. Bhavika Thakur for Computer. Besides expertise sessions, students were also provided with YouTube link to various proficiency-related videos to further expand their knowledge.

● FAMILIARIZATION OF DEPARTMENT AND INSTITUTE

The heads of all Departments briefed students about the infrastructure and various facilities available at the departments. The mentors toured the students for their specific departmental visit, as well as the library, canteen, gymkhana, and other available institute amenities, to familiarize them with the institute as a whole.






