Vision

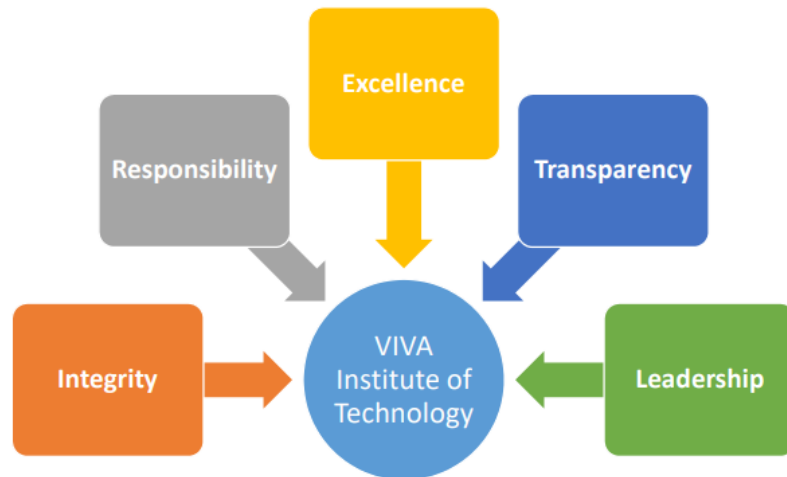

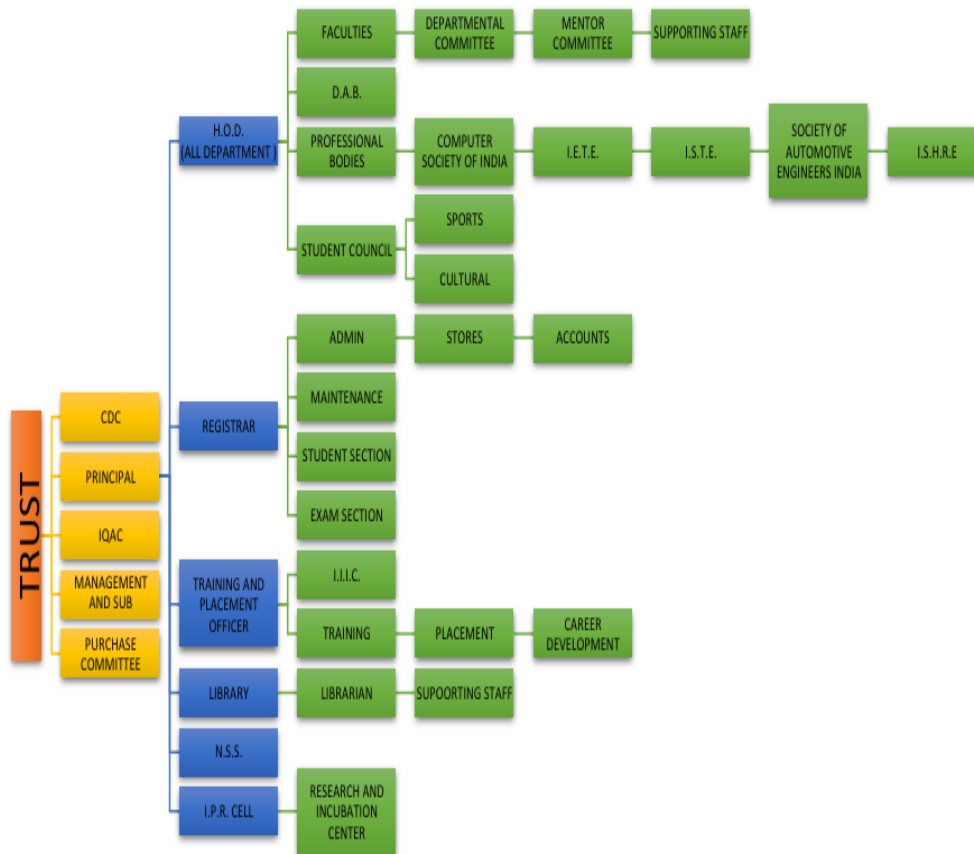

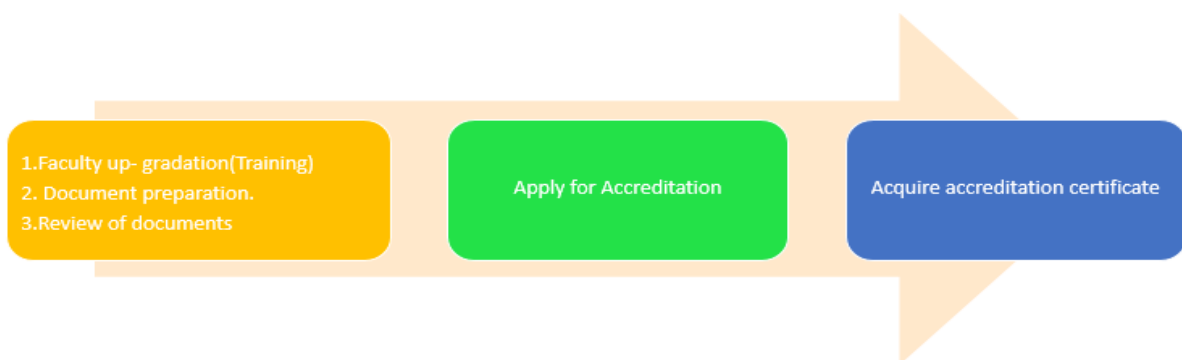

Process Cycle for Implementation of Plan and achieving Goals

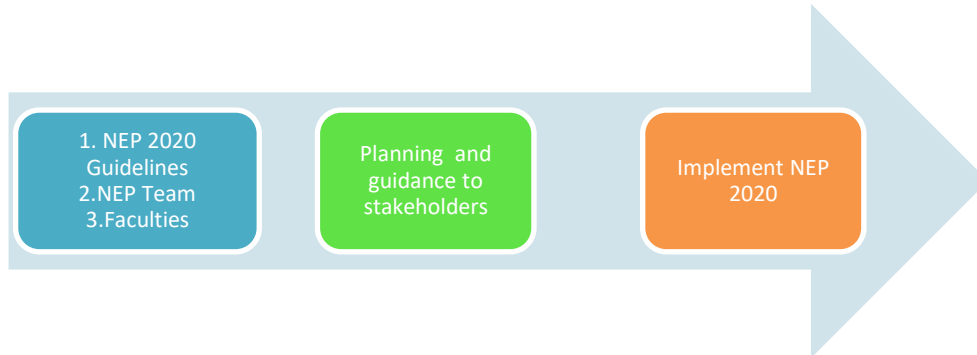
