Dr. Dipak Desai, renowned gynecologist of Vasai Taluka was present as a chief guest to give valuable speech on women's health and lifestyle management.

The program was inaugurated with the lighting of the lamp by the chief guest Dr. Deepak Desai and Dr. Arun Kumar, principal of VIVA Institute of Technology. The Principal, while introducing Dr. Deepak Desai to the audience highlighted the fact that gone are the days when women were simply home and kitchen bound. This scenario from yesteryears is so outdated and old-fashioned that nowadays, women not only handle home and a career but manage a complete overall personal growth. Due to this role reversal, many of the women lately are a victim of obesity and poor fitness regime. But complaining isn't the solution as finding a balance between personal and professional life with fitness, diet is crucial if not easy. And that's why we are here as today.

Dr. Deepak Desai brilliantly start up with the statement that "health status of women directly reflects the health status of the nation". The concept of women's health today has become a major concern among the developing countries because of deteriorating quality


